## Clarification to Hansard – Budget Estimates hearing on 23 May 2023

Dear Committee Secretary

I write to you to provide clarification of evidence I gave to the Senate Standing Committee on Legal and Constitutional Affairs during the Budget Estimates hearing on 23 May 2023.

<u>Evidence of Ms Angelene Falk, Australian Information Commissioner and Privacy</u> Commissioner.

On page 119 of the transcript, in response to a question from Senator Shoebridge regarding whether the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner asked Senator Cash to provide a copy of the document when she was a minister, I said:

Ms Falk: Yes.

I wish to clarify that my decision in *Rex Patrick and Attorney-General (Freedom of information)* [2023] AICmr 9 (28 February 2023)<sup>1</sup> states at Attachment A that "The OAIC wrote to the Department asking the then Attorney-General Cash to confirm whether she was in possession of the document at issue in this IC review."

On page 119 of the transcript, in response to a question from Senator Shoebridge regarding whether the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner asked each of the ministers to provide a copy of the document, I said:

Ms Falk: Yes.
