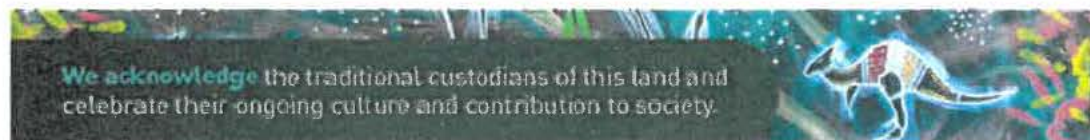

- 1. Upon review of our Settlement Request Form submitted on 29 July 2022, we note it states: "The amount of \$150,000 is a discount of 50% on actual costs expended that would be the subject of taxation in default of agreement...". We confirm this phrasing is inaccurate and provide further clarification as follows:

The ABCC/AGS's assessment of its recoverable costs under Snaden J's costs order dated 31 March 2022 is \$410,570.27 (Recoverable Costs). The ABCC then made an offer to the CFMMEU that it would agree to
