

Response to Senator Sterle – Tabled 21 October 2019

In response to Senator Glenn Sterle's questions on 14 October 2019 in relation to the following Regional Programs:

Assumptions:

- Electorate information is not recorded, except for the Stronger Communities Programme (which has electoral boundaries as a criteria)
- 'Date Funding Agreement signed' is published on GrantConnect at www.grants.gov.au
- 'Funding Breakdown between various levels of government (and other proponents where applicable), by financial year' is not recorded in a way that is able to be reported and is not relevant for all projects/programs
- 'Planning Start Date' is not recorded.

Drought Communities Programme (DCP)

The original DCP and all projects were completed by 30 June 2019. Information regarding these projects can be found on GrantConnect at www.grants.gov.au.

Murray-Darling Basin Regional Economic Diversification Programme

The program and all projects were completed by 30 June 2019 in accordance with the relevant National Partnership Agreement with the states of Victoria, Queensland and New South Wales. Information regarding these projects can be found at www.federalfinancialrelations.gov.au/content/npa/infrastructure/project-agreement/MDBREDP_Project_Agreement_2018.pdf.

Stronger Communities Programme

The Australian Government committed a further \$22.65 million in the 2019-20 Budget to deliver a fifth round of the Stronger Communities Programme (SCP), bringing the total funding for this program to \$102.75 million between 2015-16 and 2019-20.

Under SCP Round Five, funding of \$150,000 is available to support up to 20 projects in each electorate. Applicants are able to seek grants of between \$2,500 and \$20,000 and are required to match the SCP grant in cash or in-kind on at least a dollar for dollar basis.

Applications for Round Five of the SCP opened on 5 August 2019 and closed on 17 October 2019.

Projects are expected to be complete by 30 June 2020.

Outcomes of SCP grants for Round Five will be published on www.grants.gov.au.

Total funding allocated to this program for the 2019-20 financial year:

- As per page 47 of the Portfolio Budget Statements 2019-20 Budget Related Paper No. 1.12 for Infrastructure, Regional Development and Cities Portfolio funding of \$22.6 million has been allocated for the program in 2019-20.

Tasmanian Jobs and Growth Package

The program and all projects were completed by 30 June 2019. Information regarding these projects can be found on GrantConnect at www.grants.gov.au.

Community Development Grants Programme

Projects funded through the Community Development Grants Programme are required to be completed by no later than 30 June 2026.

Total funding allocated to this program for the 2019-20 financial year:

- As per page 47 of the Portfolio Budget Statements 2019-20 Budget Related Paper No. 1.12 for Infrastructure, Regional Development and Cities Portfolio funding of \$643.1 million has been allocated for the program in 2019-20.

Building Better Regions Fund

The Australian Government has announced \$200 million towards a fourth round of the Building Better Regions Fund (BBRF), bringing the total commitment for this program to \$841.6 million from 2017-18 to 2022-23. Applications for Round Four will open shortly.

Projects are expected to be complete by 31 December 2022.

Outcomes of BBRF grants for Round Four will be published on www.grants.gov.au.

Details for previous Rounds of BBRF are as follows:

- Round One projects are expected to complete by 31 December 2019.
- Round Two projects are expected to complete by 31 December 2020.
- Round Three projects are expected to complete by 31 December 2021.

Total funding allocated to this program for the 2019-20 financial year:

- As per page 47 of the Portfolio Budget Statements 2019-20 Budget Related Paper No. 1.12 for Infrastructure, Regional Development and Cities Portfolio funding of \$307.6 million has been allocated for the program in 2019-20.

Drought Communities Programme Extension

The Australian Government recently announced an additional \$13 million for the Drought Communities Programme Extension (DCP-Ext), bringing the total commitment for this program to \$123 million. The new 13 Local Government Areas (LGAs) are expected to complete their projects by 30 June 2020.

Guidelines are currently being updated and will be published on www.grants.gov.au.

Details for previous announcements of DCP-Ext are as follows:

- 81 LGAs were required to complete by 30 June 2019.
- 15 LGAs are expected to complete by 31 December 2019.
- 14 LGAs are expected to complete by 30 June 2020.

Total funding allocated to this program for the 2019-20 financial year:

- As per page 47 of the Portfolio Budget Statements 2019-20 Budget Related Paper No. 1.12 for Infrastructure, Regional Development and Cities Portfolio funding of \$15 million was allocated for the program in 2019-20. The Australian Government has also announced additional funding of \$14 million and \$13 million bringing the total funding for 2019-20 to \$42 million.

National Stronger Regions Fund

Projects under the National Stronger Regions Fund are expected to be complete by 30 June 2020.

Total funding allocated to this program for the 2019-20 financial year:

- As per page 47 of the Portfolio Budget Statements 2019-20 Budget Related Paper No. 1.12 for Infrastructure, Regional Development and Cities Portfolio funding of \$57.1 million has been allocated for the program in 2019-20.

Regional Growth Fund

Under the Regional Growth Fund there are 17 projects, of which 15 projects are underway and two projects are pending.

Projects funded through the Regional Growth Fund are expected to be completed by 30 June 2022.

Total funding allocated to this program for the 2019-20 financial year:

- As per page 47 of the Portfolio Budget Statements 2019-20 Budget Related Paper No. 1.12 for Infrastructure, Regional Development and Cities Portfolio funding of \$120.4 million has been allocated for the program in 2019-20.

Regional Jobs and Investment Packages

Projects are expected to be completed by 30 June 2020.

Total funding allocated to this program for the 2019-20 financial year:
