National Commuter Car Park Fund

In the 2019-20 Budget, funding for the Urban Congestion Fund (UCF) was increased by \$3 billion, bringing the Government's total investment to \$4 billion.

The National Commuter Car Park Fund was created as part of the UCF with \$500 million committed.

Of the \$500 million Fund, \$476 million has been allocated to specific projects.
