REPORT NO. 13 OF 2023

1. The committee met in private session on Wednesday, 8 November 2023 at 7.08 pm
2. The committee recommends that—
 - (a) the Migration Amendment (Overseas Organ Transplant Disclosure and Other Measures) Bill 2023 be *referred immediately* to the Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade Legislation Committee for inquiry and report by 30 March 2024 (see appendix 1 for a statement of reasons for referral).
