Question

Senator URQUHART: Any examples of effective overseas abatement that is now available?

Mr Jackson: There are many. Renewable energy is obviously one. Most of the projects that have been invested in to date have been in either renewable energy or energy efficiency. In terms of the particular number of projects, I can actually give you on notice the exact percentages of abatement that has occurred in the different sectors. But most projects that have happened to date have been in either renewable energy or energy efficiency.¹
