I feel this would take a lot of stress off families with disabled members and allow them easier access to facilities, information and help and know that if they for some reason can not continue looking after their disabled child that there is a back up plan in place that will help ease this burden. Any form of assurance whether it be insurance or just someone else in the same position will be of utmost importance to families.
