Racial Discrimination Amendment Bill 2016

I refer to the above Bill which has been referred to the Senate Legal and Constitutional Affairs Legislation Committee for inquiry and report by 9 May 2017.

The Bill proposes to remove the words 'offend, insult,' from section 18C(1)(a) of the Racial Discrimination Act 1975 (Cth).

The amendments proposed in this Bill have been considered recently by the Parliamentary Joint Committee on Human Rights as part of its inquiry into *Freedom of speech in Australia*. That Committee tabled a report of its findings on 28 February 2017.
