Public hearing into aircraft facilities proposed for RAAF Base Amberley

The Public Works Committee is conducting a public hearing into new facilities proposed for RAAF Base Amberley, Queensland which are required to support and maintain eight C-17A heavy airlift aircraft.

In its submission to the Committee, the Department of Defence stated that current facilities are inefficient and no longer provide adequate support. Therefore, works have been planned to improve the efficiency of engineering and maintenance operations.

The proposed works will include workshops and amenities, an aircraft apron, explosive ordnance facilities, refuelling stations and associated infrastructure such as roads, power and security services.

The project is expected to cost \$219.4 million (excluding GST).
