If I have to work weekends, I don't get the time that I need to recharge my batteries and it takes a lot out of me. If I have to suffer that, I expect a reasonable amount of compensation. I also don't get time with my family and it is difficult to catch up with them as it is, with working permanent afternoon shift.

I urge the committee to keep penalty rates. Make my life bearable.
