#### Question:

CHAIR: I'm particularly interested in the minister's role regarding the decision-making process and the development and implementation of the program guidelines. Mr McCann: I'll preface this answer by saying I don't have the details of all conversations and all meetings with respect to the development of the guidelines, but I do have some key dates. On 11 May, subsequent to some initial discussions around the development of the guidelines, we received a draft version of the guidelines from the Department of Health that were largely based on a template from the Department of Finance. There was further conversation and drafting internally. We then provided a version of that to the Department of Health later in May, on the 24th. It came back again on 31 May. There were further discussions between 31 May and 6 June. It also went through to 4 July, where program guidelines were reaffirmed again. I'm just reading a timeline here. They don't step out every conversation and meeting, but it's certainly a process between 11 May through to July. CHAIR: Are you able to provide a copy of emails or notes of what was discussed during that process?

Mr McCann: We'd have to take that on notice, specifically around the toing and froing during that period.

#### Answer:

A search of emails in ASC email accounts to or from specific Department of Health and former Minister's Office staff between the dates of 1/5/2018 to 31/7/2018 was conducted and found the attached records relating to the development of the guidelines.

#### 9.2 Who will approve grants?

Projects recommended for funding by the Expert Panel will then be submitted to the Department of Agriculture and Water Resources for recommendation to the appropriate minister in the agriculture and water resources portfolio. This minister will consider applications and make the final decisions on which applications are successful to be offered funding.

While delivery of funding will be primarily on a competitive basis, if after running each application process, emerging issues have been identified and/or there are priorities that have not been met, the minister may consider other projects to address these emerging issues or other forms of financial arrangements with partners and/or applicants, to otherwise further the objectives of the program. It is expected that, in these cases, the assessment criteria outlined in these guidelines will remain applicable.

All decisions made by the Minister about successful project applications are final. There is no appeal mechanism for decisions to approve or not approve a grant. The Minister must not approve funding if they reasonably consider the program funding available across financial years will not accommodate the funding offer, and/or the application does not represent value-for-money.
