Borroloola: Standing Up for Country

This film is about the struggle of the community of Borroloola in the Northern Territory to have the McArthur River mine shut down and cleaned up. It's a story of people who have fought to protect their land and their encouragement to all of us to do the same. It is a film by and about Aboriginal people for other Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities who are also dealing with the threat of, or issues associated with, mining. It's an example of where Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people are standing up for country in the face of huge odds. It will be used alongside the Building Power Guide to support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders to build effective community campaigns.
