National Vocational Education and Training Regulator (Data Streamlining) Amendment Bill 2023

Call for submissions

The Senate Education and Employment Legislation Committee is calling for submissions to its inquiry into the provisions of the National Vocational Education and Training Regulator (Data Streamlining) Amendment Bill 2023 (the bill) by **4 April 2023**.

The bill seeks to amend the *National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011* to support data collection and arrangements in relation to the use and disclosure of Vocational Education Training data.

The bill would allow skills ministers to delegate their powers to agree to all, or parts, of the National Vocational Education and Training Regulator (Data Provision Requirements) Instrument 2020 to other individuals or bodies, such as senior officials of the Commonwealth and states and territories.

The committee is due to report on 14 April 2023.
