Just reading about the enormous amount of plastic drink containers that end up in landfill should surely be an incentive to do something positive about this problem.

Our Landcare group regularly cleans up our local area. As we travel the Hume Freeway to Wodonga we frequently see clean up crews packing bags with cans, bottles and plastic rubbish.

These people could be better employed supporting the environment.

The time has come for all of Australia, not just South Australia, to come to terms with this ever increasing problem.

I often wonder, and feel ashamed, of what visitors from overseas think of our littering ways.
