**How many doses of the AstraZeneca vaccine do you expect to be distributed to each state before 4th April 2021?**

**Question:**

How many doses of the AstraZeneca vaccine do you expect to be distributed to each state before 4th April 2021?

a. How many of those doses are allocated to GP clinics?

**Answer:**

As at 5 April 2021 (Week 7 of the COVID-19 vaccine rollout), 2.4 million doses of the COVID-19 vaccine had been distributed. This includes both the Pfizer and AstraZeneca vaccines.

In accordance with the Commonwealth's dose allocation plan, 1.3 million doses of the AstraZeneca vaccine were delivered to Commonwealth Primary Care sites. While general practices accounted for a predominant proportion of these deliveries, a specific breakdown of primary care sites (GPs, GPRCs, and ACCHOs) is not available.

The remaining AstraZeneca and Pfizer doses were delivered to states and territories as follows:

- New South Wales: 267,740 doses
- Victoria: 267,490 doses
- Queensland: 205,880 doses
- Western Australia: 106,100 doses
- South Australia: 95,080 doses
- Tasmania: 32,730 doses
- Northern Territory: 20,310 doses
- Australian Capital Territory: 24,410 doses
