# COMMUNITY CONSULTATION REPORT DEFENCE SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY GROUP FISHERMANS BEND REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT, PORT MELBOURNE, VICTORIA

- 1. The Defence Science and Technology Group (DSTG) Fishermans Bend Redevelopment Project (the Project) was referred to the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Public Works on 20 June 2023. The Project proposes to deliver new and upgraded facilities and infrastructure at DSTG Fishermans Bend in Victoria.
- 2. This letter is to inform the Committee of the nature and extent of community consultation that has been undertaken by the Department of Defence on the Project. The aim of the consultation is to ensure local communities and other stakeholders are:
- a. well informed about the Project details through effective and proven communication channels; and
- b. provided the opportunity to raise any concerns or to seek further information so that, wherever feasible, Defence can address these within the Project.
- 3. The following stakeholder and community consultation activities have been delivered in accordance with the Project's comprehensive community engagement strategy:
- a. Advertising the details of the community information session in newspapers and neighbourhood letterbox drops. The advertisements included a Project email address to receive submissions and questions about the Project. - b. Conducting one community information session in Port Melbourne on 15 June 2023. The type of information presented at the session is at **Annex B**, and the level of attendance at the session is at **Annex C**.










