The data below highlights that the usage of JAEPA and KAFTA has roughly doubled from 2014/15 to 2015/16, since introduction (Dec14 and Jan15) so they have only been around for a short time.

CHAFTA only introduced late 2015.

Non-preferential certificates including certificates of origin, certificates of health and certificates of free sale which make up the other 50% of the documents CCI provides – excluding carnets.

Preferential certificates are specifically for FTA's and as such the information most likely relevant to the Committee. Non-preferential certificates simply record that that an export consignment of Australian origin left our shores.

For recording purposes because we do so few Chile Certificates, we don't record whether they are preferential or non-preferential.

All the other FTA's we have in place with other countries not reported below do not require certificates of origin so we don't have visibility of the usage change over time.
