## Question

**Senator O'NEILL:** Yes, buyer beware. In terms of the insider-trading matter on which your investigation is in continuance, are you able to provide any substantive update on what's happening with those investigations since we last met? Specifically with regard to Ross Doyle and the insider trading investigation, which included a travel ban, was the ban extended? What's the status of your interactions with Mr Ross Doyle?

**Mr Longo:** I'm not sure whether Deputy Chair Court has that information at her fingertips in connection with the travel ban. I'm not sure what we can say about that today.

**Ms Court:** It's probably imprudent of me, Senator, to take it. My understanding is that that travel ban was extended. I will double-check that and make sure that I'm not misleading you.

## **Answer**

On 29 June 2021 ASIC obtained orders restraining Ross Doyle from leaving Australia until 25 October 2021. On 21 October 2021 ASIC obtained orders extending Mr Doyle's travel restraint until 31 January 2022.
