Submission

The Central Tablelands Branch of NSWAA have voted unanimously that the Senate take responsibility and take action to prevent the drift of spray herbicides by farmers, land holders and corporations, through crop spraying as the drift is killing native flora which is valuable to food security and honeybee and fauna resources.

The drift of herbicides is causing the destruction of native flora including eucalypt trees that are many years old and irreplaceable.

We request the Senate take action to remedy this situation before it becomes too late.
