Unfortunately now due to this situation I decided to postpone my marriage, leaving myself emotionally distressed and confused. All these situations have left my family in stress and frustrated. It has affected my mother very badly as she is very depressed and worried.

Why doesn't DEWHA think positively? We have spent lots of money and have been left their as if everything is fine. Is this fair?

My suggestion for DEWHA is for all those assessors who have already benefited from this program (from day one to now) which are continuously working from DEWHA should be stopped and give the other assessors that did not get the opportunity to work a fair go. This way it will not affect the government's budget and will give the new assessors benefit from this scheme as well.
