Regarding - Native Vegetation Laws, Greenhouse Gas Abatement and  
Climate Change Measures

Submission –

The impact of native vegetation laws as it stands affects the ability to  
abate greenhouse gases by landowners who,

- (a) Allow land to be used for purposes other than the survival of native  
vegetative;
- (b) Since receive under-compensation for land that has been used for  
such purposes; and
- (c) Are benefactors on asset value calculation when land has be used  
for purposes the legislation deems as beneficial.
- (d) Further attention is bought to land that has been used for the  
cultivation of marijuana, ephedra, sassafras, cocaine and opium which  
has subsequently been improperly valued for reasons of law.

Please address these issues and land that has increased in value  
through these circumstances will wholly assist the proposed legislation  
through future increases in native vegetation, lower greenhouse gases,  
minimised climate changes and better valuation for owners.
