Reforms to the CATSI Act: more accountability, less red tape

The Australian Government is proposing reforms to strengthen and improve the *Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006* (CATSI Act). The reforms are intended to benefit Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander corporations by reducing red tape, especially for small corporations, and increasing transparency for members. There are also minor changes to streamline and clarify some parts of the CATSI Act.

The proposed amendments were informed by an independent technical review of the CATSI Act and stakeholder consultations undertaken as part of that review. A summary of the proposed reforms is attached, and a more detailed discussion paper will be available soon.
