Careers Australia welcomes the opportunity to make a submission to the Senate Inquiry 'into the operation, regulation and funding of private vocational education and training (VET) providers in Australia'.

TENEISHA ROSE Certificate III in Logistics



Teneisha Rose has always had a love for physical, manual work. Raised in the small town of Mareeba, she loved nothing more than getting her hands dirty and helping her dad in the large sheds.

"I've always wanted to work in a large warehouse and drive a forklift. I've been doing it since I was a young girl, but I never got my licence," she said.

At the age of twenty-one, Teneisha had all the necessary skills to work on a farm, but was finding it difficult to find full time employment and turned to study to build on her skillset and experience.

ABOUT OUR STUDENTS

At Careers Australia, we are privileged to play a part in the lives of our students who, like Jazmin Staikos mentioned on page 3, are the first person in their family to have ever achieved a tertiary qualification.

We are approved to provide access to Commonwealth Government loans through VET Fee-Help as well as a range of industry funding schemes such as the Australian Apprenticeship Incentive Program which make our education and training amongst the most accessible in the country. Our courses also feature rolling commencement dates scheduled throughout the year, giving students the flexibility to begin study as soon as possible.

We also undertake national focus groups to gain valuable feedback from our students regarding their experience while studying with us. This feedback is used to improve on our systems and evaluate our current processes.

We also seek student satisfaction ratings through regular surveys to our students. Below is an example of the survey lifecycle for a Diploma course at Careers Australia.

Careers Australia is using an EDUSCREEN assessment conducted during the profiling process which is a tool used to predict the likelihood of a student completing study and what interventions might be required based on their results to support progression.

Career Outcome Survey The tool is the result of study conducted by the University of Rhode Island. Effectively it is a "Psychological Assessment of Readiness to Change" (PARC) survey which identifies students who are most likely to complete their studies as well as those who might benefit from support and those who are not fully committed to taking action. It will enable Careers Australia to deliver effective interventions corresponding to their stage of change: ie their readiness to re-enter education.

Careers Australia provides comprehensive support to our students to ensure they have the best possible chance of gaining a qualification and successful career outcomes.

Our Student Retention Team exists to support and encourage all students enrolled into campus based Certificates and Diplomas. Students are supported from enrolment through to graduation.

Once a student enrols through any channel or method it is assigned an individual Retention Specialist (RS) to make contact with the student within two business days. The RS contacts the student to welcome them to Careers Australia, introduce themselves and establish a relationship in order to influence them to attend classes and ultimately, graduate.

The Retention Specialist is a student's biggest fan, their loudest cheer squad, the person who will help students when they need it and be there with the student right through their training. RS's are 'someone on your side', someone who really understands how the students are feeling, someone to cheer on their successes and to offer encouragement through their challenges.

There is a clear improvement in commencement rates across the various courses when students have been assigned a RS and the on-boarding and retention process has been followed. We have received positive feedback from campuses and students. Recently we have also been asking students various survey questions and we're pleased to report that over 95% of students would recommend that people study with Careers Australia.





Our courses are aligned to projected employment trends, with our product catering for over 75% of the projected employment growth for the next four years.




Careers Australia is focused on ensuring our students graduate job ready and are actively seeking employment opportunities. Our current student data reflects that **66%** of Careers Australia students are currently employed, **17%** are currently seeking employment and **17%** are undertaking further study.

Our flagship program, the Diploma of Nursing, has graduated over 1,500 students since its inception and is highly successful in job outcomes with just under 90% of our students employed or pursuing further education at the time of graduation.



40% of our graduates are working in the Aged Care Sector and 60% are working in the Acute Health Sector across a range of Private and Public Facilities including, but not limited to; QLD Health, Wesley Hospital, Epworth Hospital, John Fawkner Hospital, Royal Adelaide, Flinders Medical Centre, Health Scope, and Opal Group.

Careers Australia also has recognised articulation agreements with a wide range of Australian Universities to ensure our students can progress onto further studies should they wish to pursue a higher level qualification. Currently we have articulations with CQ University, Swinburne University, University of Southern Queensland and Southern Cross University. 38% of Careers Australia students are either pursuing Higher Education or seeking employment after graduation.

100% of our Apprenticeships and Traineeships are employed while undertaking their studies.

Careers Australia has also focused on increasing the number of Apprentices and Trainees undertaking training. In the past 12 months, we have increased our market share by 30%, a significant result considering the industry trend shows a national decrease of **14.2%**².

We actively ensure that our Apprentices and Trainees continue with their training, should any lose their employment status. We also work with our industry partners and Group Training Organisations to assist any 'out of work' Apprentices and Trainees to successfully regain employment.

Industry feedback on the new and innovative programs we are delivering has been strong and positive and reinforces our passion for what we do.



These facilities provide hands-on skills training and will cater for the growing number of students seeking education and employment opportunities.

Careers Australia takes quality and compliance as a matter of priority. We have an established Quality Unit that is independent of the delivery and operational teams. The General Manager, Quality and Risk, reports directly to the CEO which enables independent and rigorous internal audits to be conducted and reported directly to the CEO on the performance of the organisation.

Careers Australia has a Quality Management Framework that forms the basis for all quality improvement processes to implement the formal structure of a quality management system.



The business process identified in each core activity has its own evaluation mechanism inbuilt into the business process. Surveys and internal audit mechanisms are built into each of the functions.

In addition to surveys, Careers Australia also uses the results of the surveys administered for the Quality Indicators. These results are collated by the Quality Unit and are sent to the relevant business units for subsequent investigation and follow-up.

Careers Australia has also made a significant investment to create its individualised student management system, CASIS (Careers Australia Student Information System). It has designed a fully customised system that is compliant for VET Fee-Help, multiple state funding contracts, SNR, and ESOS.

- Managers able to obtain enhanced performance reporting, allowing for more informed business decisions

CASIS will support the imminent introduction of a national Unique Student Identifier across the whole VET system.

VET IN SCHOOLS

The Careers Australia VET in Schools curriculum is developed specifically for secondary school students and delivered by qualified educators with industry experience.

Our UPREP program allows students to undertake an Accredited Australian Diploma program in their final years of secondary school that provides practical business skills and theoretical knowledge of business and management practices. The course includes university readiness workshops that cover topics such as independent learning, where to find support at university, guidance for writing a variety of assessments, database searching and referencing.

Studying via UPREP could be the first step on the pathway to university success or career ambitions. By developing skills and knowledge in an adult learning environment, students gain both confidence and qualifications to prepare them for a bright future.

Entry requirements for UPREP

UPREP requires students to be working towards a SACE and to have sufficient language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) skills. To determine a student's suitability for UPREP, each student is required to undertake a LLN test administered by Careers Australia and participate in a formal interview.

Benefits for students

- In accordance with the SACE Board's Recognition of VET Policy, students will receive 10 credits for every 70 nominal hours or 5 credits for every 35 nominal hours of successfully completed VET study. The Diploma of business can provide students with approximately 65 credits.
- Students can be eligible to receive up to one year of credit towards related tertiary qualifications at some universities.
- A nationally recognised and industry respected qualification that will assist students gain employment while pursuing further study.

School based Apprenticeships and Traineeships

School based Apprenticeships or Traineeships allow you to work for an employer as a paid employee and undertake training towards a recognised qualification, whilst completing your secondary school studies. School based Apprenticeships combine high school study, training and paid work. On completion of year 12, you will receive your senior certificate and have trained towards a Certificate qualification in your chosen career, as well as being paid for your time spent working.
