Thank you for the opportunity to make a submission to the Senate Legal and Constitutional Affairs Committee's inquiry into the appropriate terms of reference for a COVID-19 Royal Commission.

The Tasmanian Government does not believe that there is a need for a COVID-19 Royal Commission as each state and territory has already undertaken numerous reviews or inquiries into their response to the pandemic. In Tasmania, this includes the following inquiries:

The Tasmanian Government recognises the value in identifying lessons learned from the COVID-19 response to improve Australia's preparedness for future pandemics. We are currently engaging with the Commonwealth Government's COVID-19 Response Inquiry and will provide a submission to that Inquiry.

If there is to be a COVID-19 Royal Commission, the Tasmanian Government recommends the terms of reference focus on making recommendations to improve Australia's response in the event of future pandemics, similar to the terms of reference for the current COVID-19 Response Inquiry. They should stipulate that the findings of previous inquiries and reviews undertaken both at a federal level and by individual states and territories be considered to avoid duplicating work. Our Government does not believe it would be appropriate for actions taken by individual states and territories to be within the scope of a COVID-19 Royal Commission.
