**TAFE student survey now live**

A survey for future, present and past TAFE students is now live on the Standing Committee on Education and Employment's website. This survey forms part of evidence gathering for the Committee's inquiry in TAFE and its operations.

The survey is aimed at getting an overview of what students believe are the most important areas of the TAFE system, how they believe their qualifications are recognised, and any shortfalls that they see the TAFE system has.

The Committee Chair, Member for Herbert, Mr Ewen Jones MP, says that student's opinions are a valuable part of the inquiry, especially as they are the future of the Australian workforce.

"It is important to capture how students feel about their TAFE system. Students are future employees, managers and business owners and an integral part of this inquiry is to support them to achieve their education and employment goals. Feedback from students via this survey will enable the Committee to gain a different insight into the TAFE system that could be lacking through other evidence gathering methods" he said.
