Did Dr Henry Cheng's membership of the 12th Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference—the CPPCC—of the People's Republic of China factor into Treasury's analysis of sale with regard to character?

ACTING CHAIR: Was Dr Henry Cheng's membership of the CPPCC included in a briefing to the then Treasurer, Mr Scott Morrison, with respect to the sale of Alinta?

Ms Kelley: We would have to take that on notice.

ACTING CHAIR: Was Dr Henry Cheng's membership of the CPPCC included in a briefing to the then Minister for the Environment and Energy, now the Treasurer, Mr Josh Frydenberg, with respect to the sale of Alinta?
