RE: Inquiry into Renewable Energy (Electricity) Amendment (Excessive Noise from Wind Farms) Bill 2012

I live in close proximity to the proposed Bald Hills Wind Farm Development. This proposed development has deeply affected our local community and resulted in considerable financial cost and emotional stress for many local residents.

I am fundamentally opposed to the construction of wind turbines at the above-mentioned location due to the excessive noise that the wind turbines will potentially generate, particularly as the heights of the turbines approved for this site were increased in 2009 without any further noise modeling being undertaken. If the Wind Farm is allowed to proceed it will have a detrimental affect on all nearby properties. In my case, it will directly impact my family, which includes two small children under the age of seven.

I believe it is imperative that the bill is accepted in order to protect the rights and health of nearby landholders.
