## Hearing on Australian Government Contracting

The Joint Committee of Public Accounts and Audit will hear from a range of witnesses tomorrow at the Committee's second public hearing inquiring into Australian Government Contract Reporting.

The Committee's inquiry is based on Auditor-General's Information Report—[Australian Government Procurement Contract Reporting](#) (Audit Report No. 19, 2017–18).

During the hearing the Committee will consider:

- matters raised from the Auditor-General's reporting of AusTender contract data over a five-year period (2012–13 to 2016–17); and
- participating entities' views on the five areas of focus highlighted in the Committee's [Complementary Submission Guidance](#), including contracting trends across the Australian Public Service, transparency of contract reporting and Australian Public Service capability and capacity.

Committee Chair [Senator Dean Smith](#) said the inquiry offers an opportunity to review evidence from Commonwealth entities as well as other key stakeholders on the effective use of external consultants and contractors, including value-for-money, as well as existing contract reporting systems.

"Transparency in contract reporting and the consistent application of the Australian Government's procurement policies and framework is essential to set and maintain a high standard of policy delivery by the public service," Senator Smith said.
