Hansard reference:

Mr CONROY: Could the department provide a list of the—I think there are 26 projects? In paragraph 3.10, with the four categories, we have 88 projects located in an electorate where a coalition member held the seat before the election and retained it. We have 36 projects where the coalition won the seat. Could you list the electorates with the three projects where the coalition lost the seat? And, in a separate table, could you list the electorates with the 23 projects where the coalition were unsuccessful in winning that seat? I would just be interested in what electorates we are talking about here.

Mr Anderson: Just to confirm that: one list that identifies the three; and one that identifies the 23—

Mr CONROY: Yes, please. Could you provide the list of all projects in the four categories?

Mr Anderson: Do you want four separate lists?

Mr CONROY: Yes—just so that we can understand according to those four dot points.

Mr CONROY: Canvassed on page 29 of the summary, there is a clear financial criteria as part of the guidelines for scoring. Twenty-eight applications did not include a quote for the crime-prevention solution, the CCTV cameras, for example; nevertheless, the department provided satisfactory scoring against that criteria. How could the department say that this financial information is satisfactory if no quote had been provided?

Mr Anderson: Again, this is a deficiency noted by the ANAO. It is a deficiency we have taken on board and we are keen to ensure we do not do this again. We agree it is preferable to have quotations, in order to be sure that an estimate of funding is reasonable, in all circumstances. Otherwise, I agree, you are forced to have regard to other applications. For example, you can roughly make an estimate to say if one application has quotations and they say it is going to cost a certain amount to install a certain type of security structure, you can perhaps draw a line from that to another application where there is not a quotation and say that it seems to be commensurate. But I agree, it is not as robust as if you have quotations there with every application.

Mr CONROY: Could you provide, on notice, the total amount funded, covering those 28 applications?

Mr Anderson: Yes, certainly.
