## Inquiry into targeted sanctions to address human rights abuses Submission 8

I wish to request that Magnitsky-type legislation be adopted in Australia. It would prohibit the entry of murderers and thieves who, because of their official positions and corruptible legal systems in their own countries, would not face judgement for their crimes. Indeed, they might try to get away with such crimes in Australia if allowed in.

Furthermore, their family members and associates should be prohibited. None of them should be permitted to use services or obtain goods and property here

If such individuals are credentialled and sent here in an official capacity by their governments, they should likewise be prohibited. This would help to protect the rights of their compatriots resident in Australia, whose relatives at home could be endangered.
