

Dear Enquiry

I've been to SE Qld and seen what a disaster CSG is on the land surface there; I've seen what a social disaster it is; the pipeline to Gladstone is a huge imposition on the environment; dredging the harbour there is having shocking effects on marine life; and I believe Governments' and the CSG industry's unwillingness to examine the environmental side-effects of CSG (stray gas emissions, ground- and surface water pollution, displacement of agriculture) is indicative of a scam.

In my home area, we've voted 98% not to allow it. This is a similar result to most in my region.

I write to make you aware of:

1. my own sentiments as outlined above;
2. the votes I mention, determined by door-knocking every residence in these areas. Please contact me if you need more information on the votes;
