### **ABOUT**

The UWA Africa Research Cluster was launched on 25 May 2015, the annual anniversary of "Africa Day", as a new initiative to develop, coordinate and promote high-quality, relevant and ethical Africa-related research at UWA, including early career academic and postgraduate research.

It provides a mechanism for developing and deepening UWA research collaborations and other engagements with relevant local, national and international partners from academia, government, industry, community and not-for-profit sectors, including from the African continent and the African Diaspora in Australia.

The Cluster's membership of approximately 50 UWA staff and postgraduate students spans a range of fields including Political Science & International Relations; Law; Agriculture and Environment; Biological Science; Molecular Science; Engineering; Earth Sciences; Archaeology & Heritage Studies; Medicine; Population Health; History; Development Studies; Sociology; the Institute of Agriculture and the Oceans Institute.
