#		Recommendation	Government Response
1	1	The committee recommends that the Australian Government enact the Exposure Draft of the Candidate Qualification Checklist.	Noted  The Government notes the recommendation. Given the passage of time, a substantive government response is no longer appropriate.

## Dissenting report by Australian Greens

#	Recommendation	Government Response
1	That the government initiate a referendum to amend section 44 of the Constitution to allow public servants and dual citizens to stand for election to Federal parliament.	Refer to recommendation 1 of the Majority Report.

#	Recommendation	Government Response
2	In the interim, the government introduce legislation to guarantee public servants who stand down from their role to run for election a right to return to work if they are not elected.	Refer to recommendation 1 of the Majority Report.
3	That the government implement recommendations of the Australian Human Rights Commission's Set the Standard review to ensure a more diverse and representative parliament.	Refer to recommendation 1 of the Majority Report.
