## Digital Delivery Advance Questions on Notice — National Disability Insurance Agency SQ18-000002

## Senator Patrick has asked:

Can the National Disability Insurance Agency provide the following information on the delivery of the NDIA Full Scheme ICT solution program?

- 1. The budget for the project at the time of first approval to proceed?
- 2. The spend to date on the project?
- 3. The current approved budget?

## **Answer:**

- 1. The Commonwealth Government confirmed in the 2015 Budget that \$143 million had been provided to design and build a fit-for-purpose and scalable ICT system suitable for full Scheme. Funding was granted over four years, commencing in 2015-16. The National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) share of the funding is \$30.2 million. The remaining \$112.8 million has been allocated to the Department of Human Services and the Department of Social Services.
- 2. At 31 December 2017, the NDIA had spent a total of \$27.3 million over the span of the NDIA full Scheme ICT solutions program.
- 3. For the financial year 2017-18, the NDIA budget is allocated at \$9.1 million.
