Advance Questions on Notice — National Disability Insurance Agency**

Senator Patrick has asked:

Can the National Disability Insurance Agency provide the following information on the delivery of the NDIA Full Scheme ICT solution program?

1. The budget for the project at the time of first approval to proceed?
2. The spend to date on the project?
3. The current approved budget?

Answer:

1. The Commonwealth Government confirmed in the 2015 Budget that \$143 million had been provided to design and build a fit-for-purpose and scalable ICT system suitable for full Scheme. Funding was granted over four years, commencing in 2015-16. The National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) share of the funding is \$30.2 million. The remaining \$112.8 million has been allocated to the Department of Human Services and the Department of Social Services.
2. At 31 December 2017, the NDIA had spent a total of \$27.3 million over the span of the NDIA full Scheme ICT solutions program.
3. For the financial year 2017-18, the NDIA budget is allocated at \$9.1 million.
