Department of Veterans' Affairs grant funding for sports or sports-related activities under Veteran and Community Grants and Supporting Younger Veterans programs 2021-22 and 2020-21

The Veteran and Community Grants (V&CG) program supported activities and services that sustained and/or enhanced health and wellbeing of veterans. It provided seed funding for projects that support a healthy, quality lifestyle for members of the veteran community and assist them to remain living independently in their own homes.

The Supporting Younger Veterans (SYV) program was designed to support the needs of younger veterans (military service post-1999) as they leave the Australian Defence Force (ADF) and integrate back into civilian life. The aim of the program was to deliver services to the younger veterans' community to build capacity for the future, as well as expanding on existing or well established services offered to the younger veterans' community to new regions within Australia, this was achieved, by funding organisations that could sustainably deliver services to the younger veterans' community now and into the future.
