## WOLLONGONG CITY COUNCIL – SUBMISSION RELATING TO OPTIONS FOR FINANCING FASTER RAIL

Wollongong City Council appreciates the opportunity to make a submission to the Inquiry into Options for Financing Faster Rail.

We appreciate the priority given to provide faster rail journey times between Wollongong and Sydney. This is a significant priority for Council as the commute time between the Illawarra and Sydney on the current Illawarra rail corridor is currently more than hour and a half each way, significantly impacting on the quality of life for those working in Sydney.

Council also strongly supports the proposal to complete the Maldon to Dombarton rail link as a dual-purpose passenger and freight line to provide access to South Western Sydney and the new Badgerys Creek Aerotropolis which has the potential to transform and provide mutual benefits to the local economies of Wollongong, South Western Sydney and the Aerotropolis. This dual-purpose rail link is referred to locally as the South Western Illawarra Rail Link or 'SWIRL'.

Council will be happy to be involved in any proposals to develop and deliver faster rail between Wollongong and Sydney but we have no specific suggestions for a funding model to finance faster rail.
