Introduction

The employment statistics contained in this Bulletin are compiled from returns received from Departments and major branches of Departments showing the number of permanent, temporary and exempt staff at 30th June, 1960. All employees, whether they are permanent, temporary or exempt, are classified into four divisions - First Division, Second Division, Third Division and Fourth Division. There are no temporary employees in the First or Second Divisions; and there are no exempt employees in the First Division.

First Division officers consist of all permanent heads of Departments and a very small number of the most senior officers.

Second Division is defined to include those officers who, under officers of First Division, are required to exercise executive or professional functions in the more important offices of the Service.

Third Division consists of officers carrying out a wide variety of administrative, clerical, professional, scientific and technical work in the Service.

Fourth Division consists mainly of artisans, typists, clerical assistants, postal workers, manual workers, etc. and includes all officers not in other Divisions.

Permanent Officers are officers who are permanently employed under the conditions set out in the Public Service Act and Regulations. The Act divides these officers into four divisions (see above).

Temporary Staff are employees, employed under sections of the Public Service Act and Regulations, who have no permanent status but are entitled to normal Service conditions of pay, leave, etc. during their term of employment. Legally, they have no divisional status, but it is usual to treat them as Third or Fourth Division employees according to the positions they occupy. There are no temporary employees in the Northern Territory or Overseas.

Exempt employees are those whose engagement is exempted, for various reasons, from the application of specified provisions of the Public Service Act and Regulations. The terms and conditions of employment of exempt employees (except in so far as the Act and Regulations remain applicable) are determined by the Public Service Board. As with temporary employees, legally, exempt staff have no divisional status but are included in the Second, Third or Fourth Divisions according to the positions they occupy.

Figures for certain major branches of Departments are shown separately. The names of the major branches are shown as insets in the first column of each table under the appropriate Departmental heading. In these cases the employment shown against the Departmental heading represents the number of employees in the Department other than those in the major branches. For example, the figures shown against the Health Department are for employees other than those employed in the Serum Laboratories.

# Preface

---

The aim of this bulletin is to provide a statistical summary of the size and composition of the Australian Public Service at 31 December 1989, and of staff movements in the calendar year 1989.

This bulletin is the third in a new series of statistical publications which reflect the major redevelopment of the Continuous Record of Personnel, the main data base from which APS statistics are produced. The twice yearly bulletins provide statistics relative to the preceding calendar year, as this bulletin does (Bulletin A), or the preceding financial year (Bulletin B). Together they provide all the information covered in previous yearbooks, but with improved frequency, accuracy and timeliness. Additionally, statistical overviews and special studies are being incorporated.

The bulletin is concerned with measuring characteristics of the **staff** employed within the Australian Public Service. In technical terms, it limits its scope to all staff employed under the **Public Service Act, 1922**. It employs a headcount concept in the presentation of its statistics ie part-time persons, inoperatives - paid or unpaid - are aggregated with full-timers without weighting. This differs from other concepts such as Average Staffing Level (ASL) often used in the presentation of human resource statistics.

When referring to the statistics of this publication, the reader is asked to bear in mind the conceptual and definitional limitations (of the statistics) and to refer to the Explanatory Notes for their correct interpretation.

Before making comparisons of statistics contained in this bulletin and previous yearbooks, consideration should be given to the following:

- changes to the Administrative Arrangements Order where in some instances the composition of a Department of State has changed without a departmental name change,
- changes in the coverage of the Public Service Act (information on changes in Act coverage since 1 July 1980 is given in Appendix 1),
- corrigenda for the Statistical Bulletin B 1988-89 (see Appendix 2).
- abolition of the four-tier divisional structure of the Australian Public Service from 1 July 1984,
- introduction of permanent part-time employment from 6 May 1986,
- abolition of the EXEMPT category of employee within the Australian Public Service from 1 July 1986, and
- implementation of the Administrative Service Officer (ASO) structure from 24 December 1987.
