I came to Australia in 2006 with lots of hope and dreams of better life for me and my family. I had studied here and spent lot money on that. I was the university topper each semester and I achieve 12 higher Distinction out of 16 subjects. My GPA is 6.675 out of 7. I was very positive to get a job related to my study just because of my knowledge and my qualification, but all my dreams were broken when all my application thrown back to me by saying I don't have experience or I am not an Australian citizen. So far I have applied more than 500 jobs on-line but not a single successful answer. Then to maintain my family I have choose to work as a production worker where I got a chance after few months to work as a data entry operator on casual basis, I worked in this role for 16 month. During this time I have tried to convince my employer to give me either permanent position or a contract of sponsor me under Employer Nominated Scheme, but the company wasn't ready for any of this option. Finally they send me back to production in last January and then I have left the job in April.

After spending plenty of money, studying hard and achieving good qualification, having good knowledge of each of my subjects and willing to relocate anywhere in Australia, nothing helped me to get a study related job. I can see a good prospects and a wonderful future of my daughter and son and that's why I have choose Australia. My brother is in UK since 1996 and my sister is in USA from 1998 but I was always looking for a safe, quiet and peaceful place to spend my life and so I have come to Adelaide. I got 7 bands in each module of IELTS after 5 attempts and then lodge my PR file under visa class 885. I have nominated Computing professional as my nominated occupation, but I also got my Secondary School Teacher skills assessment few days back. This means I can work as a teacher here but now when I heard that government is planning to introduce visa capping, I was shocked. It took longer for me came out of depression when I wasn't getting any positive reply of my job application back in 2008 and now I am feeling the same depression when I heard this news. I am not sure what will happen tomorrow and what you, as a government will decide for the future, but I feel that all my dreams never come true. This will be the same case for so many others like me. So please consider our kind request to look for some other alternatives for the migration. Please see this matter with our eyes.
