Call for submissions

The Senate Education and Employment Legislation Committee is calling for submissions to its inquiry into the Fair Work Amendment (Paid Family and Domestic Violence Leave) Bill 2022 by 19 August 2022.

The bill seeks to amend the *Fair Work Act 2009* to provide for ten days of paid family and domestic violence leave in the National Employment Standards, replacing the existing entitlement to five days of unpaid family and domestic violence leave.
