It is very sad to see icons such as the ABC being trashed. If those making the decisions really loved the ABC they wouldn't do it!!

We pay taxes to help provide some independent thinking and depth in various programs than those dominated by private interests, eg. Gina Rhinehart; Murdoch rubbish; etc. Murdoch's interests have been seen to be corruptive for years providing his view of the world!
