My name is ...who is holding bridging visa A to applying for Permanent resident. I am writing to express my objection to the Migration Amendment (Visa Capping) Bill 2010.

I have been Australia for nearly 3 years since 18/07/2007 after quitting the high income job in China. The reason I made such decision is because Australia is such a country full of freedom and democracy. Then I spent 2 years learning in Tafe and work as casual in my spare time in the meanwhile I felt find my dreamland at final. During this period, I met my husband and married here. With the changing of immigration rules, our application process(started from 21/08/09) was extended from 3 month to 2 years which didn't stop our life step at all. We planned the future and tried to settle here as all other local family.

We trust the Australia government will deal with all the immigration cases just and equitable, so we were waiting for the result patiently and working full-time as Australia citizen and paid tax by law even though we didn't get any benefit from Australia government for buying a house and having a baby.

This of course is very alarming when we knew The Migration Amendment (Visa Capping) Bill 2010 which will totally crash our life and plan in a sudden because it gives the Minister of Immigration such significant power to capping any visa class among the waiting list.

If the bill will be approved, it means the minister of immigration will have the power to stop and kill people's dream subjectively. This bill is a passport to destroy not only our youth, our energy with local person during these years and the plan to spend rest life here to make more contribution to this country, the home we bought just 1 month ago, the new relationship and friendship we started to make and etc but also hundreds and thousands of similar dream and life. It is extremely unfair for the people in the "pipeline" to have the goal posts changed on us, especially when we are so close to the end of the migration process.

Please stop The Migration Amendment (Visa Capping) Bill and we should be treated fairly and justly.
