At all times good, better and best practices have been at the forefront of who we are and what we do in the North Australian cattle industry.

Our responsibility to provide protein to South East Asia has now been highjacked by a government who proclaim "to do the right thing". The 4 corners footage was indefensible and yet the public who dictated to the Minister to play games with our Live Export Trade have no knowledge or concern for bio-security and food production.

We are totally dependent on the Live Export Trade. Our industry and reputation have been unfairly tarnished and as every effort is being adopted to rectify the dreadful damage, I hold grave fears for the future of Australian agriculture. My heart and mind and soul churn for the future of millions of cattle and thousands of people including my eight darling grandchildren.
