Question

Can you take on notice and let us know to what extent that is occurring—

Perhaps with the number of projects and as much detail as you possibly can—I do not want full detail—to tell us about the types of projects and how many?

Ms Wall—*We could give you the number of projects that have a co-contribution, and we should be able to total the value of the co-contribution.*

Answer

As at 18 January 2010, the number of *Primary Schools for the 21st Century* projects that were reported as having a co-contribution, and the value of the co-contribution, by state, is as follows:
