INQUIRY INTO THE FINANCIAL REGULATORY FRAMEWORK AND HOME OWNERSHIP

The National Housing Supply and Affordability Council thanks the Senate Economics References Committee for inviting a submission to the inquiry into the financial regulatory framework and home ownership.

The Council wishes to draw attention to its <u>report on Barriers to Institutional Investment</u>, <u>Finance and Innovation in housing</u>, which focused on what can be done to increase the supply of secure homes in a rental format for more Australians, including in the affordable sector, via institutional investment.

Secondly, the Council wishes to draw attention to its inaugural <u>State of the Housing System</u> <u>report</u>, which references the Council's vision for Australia's housing system and outlines an avenue for the way forward.
