We wish to draw the Committee's attention to the significant research activity relevant to the Committee's Inquiry conducted through the Australian Government's \$40 million Marine and Tropical Sciences Research Facility (MTSRF). The MTSRF is managed and delivered by the Reef and Rainforest Research Centre (RRRC) and is using solution science to increase sustainability of management and Queensland's environmental assets - including the Torres Strait.

A plain-English summary of just a few of the Torres Strait projects that might be of interest to the Committee can be found in a recent issue of the RRRC Communique.
