The attached diagram sent to me from The Bald Hills Wind Farm Developer clearly shows that most of my farm will be severely impacted. In fact the modelled level by the Wind Farm Developer shows 40 dB and above which is way in excess of the sensible, realistic, safe and fair level of 10 dB set out in the proposed Bill.

In 2009 the tower heights allowable were increased and I would like to question the modelled noise levels of the Bald Hills Wind Farm Developer. I believe that in certain wind directions and at certain wind speeds the noise will peak well above the modelled levels shown on the attached map. This Bill reflects a fair and reasonable outcome to protect the rights of landholders and it is extremely important that it is accepted.

The fact is that wind farm noise (Audible Noise, Low Frequency Noise and Vibration Noise) is currently unregulated and this is not a sustainable situation for neighbours up to 6 kilometers from Wind Turbine Towers.
