Answer:

On 21 August 2019, the Prime Minister responded to requests from both the Senator the Hon Richard Colbeck and the Hon Michael McCormack MP approving the transfer of sport infrastructure projects of \$2 million or less that aligned with the sport and recreation priorities of the Health portfolio, from the Community Development Grants (CDG) Programme to the Department of Health.
