How many people 50 and over are receiving JobSeeker currently, compared to the number receiving Newstart at the same time last year?

Answer:

At 26 June 2020, there were 457,715 JobSeeker Payment recipients aged 50 and over, compared to 259,516 Newstart Allowance recipients aged 50 and over at 28 June 2019.
