# Inquiry into vocational education and training in South Australia

# Introduction

The Department of Education and Training (the department) welcomes the Committees' invitation to make a submission to its inquiry into vocational education and training in South Australia.

# Funding and responsibilities

The Australian Government provides significant funding to states and territories to run their own training systems, including TAFEs in their jurisdictions, through specific purpose payments and National Partnership Agreements. However, it is a state government responsibility to decide how much funding to provide to training, and how it should be spent, including training subsidy lists, subsidy levels and other funding arrangements for training providers. TAFEs are owned by state and territory governments. The South Australian Government is responsible for determining TAFE budgets, course offerings and locations of delivery.

In 2016, the South Australian Government invested approximately \$179.7 million for vocational education and training (VET). Table 1 shows the revenue from the South Australian Government for VET from 2012 to 2016:

# Commonwealth direct program funding to TAFE SA

TAFE SA receives Commonwealth funding to deliver training services under a number of programs managed by the department—currently the Australian Apprenticeships programs, Adult Migrant English Program and Skills for Education and Employment program. In addition, the Commonwealth supports TAFE SA through the provision of income-contingent loans, such as VET Student Loans, to eligible students accessing approved higher level VET qualifications.

# Commonwealth funding to support state and territory training systems

## National Agreement for Skills and Workforce Development (NASWD)

The current National Agreement for Skills and Workforce Development (NASWD) was agreed to by the Council of Australian Governments (COAG) on 13 April 2012.

The NASWD is a high-level agreement between all jurisdictions and is associated with the Skills and Workforce Development Specific Purpose Payment (SPP) of around \$1.5 billion per year made to states and territories.

SPP payments are distributed among the states and territories in accordance with population shares, based on the Australian Statistician's determination of States' population shares as at 31 December of that year. Table 2 indicates the SPP payments made to South Australia from 2012-13.

## National Partnership Agreement on Skills Reform (NPASR)

The NPASR was a five-year agreement, signed in 2012, valued at \$1.75 billion. It ended on 30 June 2017.

The NPASR set objectives and outcomes to be achieved through a range of outputs in relation to structural reforms and training outcomes.

The Commonwealth and states and territories agreed Implementation Plans that set out each jurisdiction's strategies and actions for delivering VET system structural reforms, improvements in training outcomes and other activities.

SA was assessed to meet its milestones set in the Implementation Plan for all the five years from 2012 to 2016 and therefore full payment was made under NPASR (see Table 2). ## **Skilling Australians Fund**

Over 2017–18 to 2020–21, an estimated \$1.5 billion will be available to the new and ongoing Skilling Australians Fund (the Fund). The Fund is for payments to the states and territories through a new partnership agreement. With matched funding from the states and territories, the Fund will support up to 300,000 more apprentices, trainees, pre- and higher-level apprentices over the next four years. Spending from the Fund will be prioritised towards projects brought forward from state and territory governments which support apprenticeships and traineeships in: occupations in demand, industries and sectors of future growth, trade apprenticeships, and rural and regional Australia.

South Australia will be eligible for an estimated \$24.5 million in 2017–18, \$25.1 million in 2018–19, \$27 million in 2019–20 and \$25.4 million in 2020–2021 dependent on the SA Government signing the new partnership agreement for the Skilling Australians Fund, agreeing projects and demonstrating delivery against clear milestones.

## VET FEE-HELP/VET Student Loans provided to TAFE SA

VET Student Loans are available for those courses specified on the approved course list, in the form of the *VET Student Loans (Courses and Loan Caps) Determination 2016*. Schedule 3 of the Determination sets out approved courses that may be offered only by specified providers.

Listed and not-for-profit providers were invited to apply for the inclusion of courses on Schedule 3 in December 2016 and again in March 2017. Courses added to Schedule 3 presented evidence of good employment outcomes, employer support, and a track record of student progression and completion through a particular course.

As at 8 January 2018, TAFE SA had one course on Schedule 3 of the Courses and Loan Caps Determination (Compilation No. 2), SIR50212 Diploma of Visual Merchandising.

From 1 January 2017 to 30 June 2017, TAFE SA was paid \$1,829,193 for over 900 enrolments for VET Student Loans. Details of these payments are available at Table 3.

Historical VET FEE-HELP statistics in relation to TAFE SA were also provided at Tables 4 and 5.

# **VET Activity data for TAFE SA**

In 2016, there were 83,680 program enrolments and 51,965 government-funded program enrolments at TAFE SA. Tables 6 and 7 show TAFE SA's enrolment number by year, whenever relevant data is available. Table 6 also compares enrolments at TAFEs from 2014 to 2016 in Australia.
